It is often said that a familiar scent or fragrance has the greatest capacity to evoke a distant memory with clarity rivaling modern day digital media. Each of us can provide numerous fascinating examples to illustrate...a fragrant perfume that reminds us of a loved one, the smell of moth balls that makes us feel as though we have entered a residence visited long in our past. These smells are infinite in number and yet as unique as human DNA.

Using this analogy, allow me to submit the word Christmas. If the King’s English is your preferred means of communication, then there is only one way to spell Christmas. This one word perhaps has the strongest association to our memories than any other. I am sure that when most of us think of Christmas, at some point we come across, or even arrive at the thought of gifts.

At Christmas we are presented with gifts of all kinds. There are those that we find boxed and wrapped under the tree, the gift of family and friends, and of course the gift of the Lord to those whom acceptance is predicated on faith. We think of this gift, made complete years later upon the cross, as that of eternal, peaceful life beyond our earthly existence. However, I think this gift begins here on earth. We all can think of a person or persons we’ve come across in our lives whose faith is beyond question. They sometimes possess a zeal bordering on the evangelical, while others may quietly live out their life among the “frozen chosen.” Despite these differences of “style” they all have one thing in common. They are impervious to hardships of life and the human condition. I have never witnessed true stress, worry, or fear in such persons. Their faith is like a suit of armor. It may not be shiny and smooth, it may have dents and scratches, but it remains impenetrable from life’s projectiles.

I think persons such as these have made the most of the gift of Christ. As my family convenes on Christmas morning to exchange presents and revel in the celebration of The Gift, I know that as a parent my role in giving gifts occurs daily. The greatest gift we can give our children is to raise them to have faith, a faith which will protect them beyond our reach. The armor is made of faith. It is malleable and requires shaping and fitting. It will not have the same appearance as others, but if it is carefully crafted, it will be impenetrable.
