

In this week's Bible verse, Jesus speaks of unexpected tragedy and loss, and the urgency we should feel because we are not promised tomorrow. Some of you know of the tragic death of my parents in a car accident. And although that event greatly impacted my life, I want to speak to a different event with a positive outcome that God used to change my perspective.

When my husband, Freddie, was diagnosed with a rare cancer at 35 years old, our world was shaken. It was a powerful reminder that we are not in control. Suddenly, material possessions lost their importance - life is not about all of the things we can acquire, but about the kind of impact we can make while we are here on Earth. I don't feel the same level of entitlement and naiveté that I once had. I now understand that my presence in this world is not about me at all. It's about how God can use me to do his work. I'm still human and am not perfect by any means, but I make an effort each day to be a little better than the day before. Now, I focus on gratitude for what I have instead of fixating on what I don't have.

After Jesus discusses unexpected tragedy, he uses a parable about a fig tree to warn us against false reassurance. I may have been a cultivated tree before Freddie's cancer diagnosis, but was I "bearing fruit" to my fullest potential? Just because we are a tree that has not been cut down, we cannot presume that we are producing all of the fruit that we are capable of. We must continually challenge ourselves. Are we finding ways to make the world around us better each day? Are we a cultivated, yet unproductive tree or are we a tree that is bearing fruit and using all of our spiritual gifts to the fullest every day? Although God shows us patience and mercy, He still expects us to use our gifts to help others.

As we go about our week, I challenge each of us to consider our mindset and the choices we'd make if we knew this week were our last. What a dynamic impact we could make in our community if all of us felt the urgency to be as fruitful as possible and acted upon it.
