watching those fish.



Like many adults, I have some vague and scattered childhood memories of Sunday School. I do recall there was an aquarium with fish there which always fascinated me. Back then I thought of the Sunday School classroom as just "the place in church with the fish tank." Although I am sure they also taught Bible lessons there, and I know that I learned some of those Bible lessons while

One lesson did stick with me. It was a Bible lesson about the differences between the Old Testament and New Testament. There was some talk of timelines and authors and other complicated stuff. But at the end the teacher summed it up in a neat line: "The New Testament is all about Jesus; and Jesus is all about forgiveness." That seemed pretty straightforward, in language I could understand. It's funny what sticks with you over time. The real world is no Sunday School, and the lessons we learn are pretty far removed from those simpler times. Our modern world is a world of tasks, of deadlines, of getting things done. We spend a lot of time fretting about what we didn't get done; or getting cross at those around us who didn't deliver. That Bible lesson has morphed into a little line, "... it's all about forgiveness." And for me that line is a tiny daily devotional... a little shield against troubles of all shapes and sizes. It's what I whisper when I take a deep breath, after I've made a mistake or seen someone else make one.

It's what I tell my kids when they fight. It's how I re-group when things don't go as planned. And to think I learned it way back in Sunday School, watching those fish swim around their little aquarium.
