Jesus said to her, "Do not hold on to me, because I have not yet ascended to the Father.

But go to my brothers and say to them,

'I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.'

Mary Magdalene went and announced to the disciples,

'I have seen the Lord; and she told them that he had said these things to her.'

John 20:17-18

Before sunrise, Mary Magdalene went to the tomb of Jesus and saw that the stone had been removed from the tomb. Upset, she runs back to Peter and another unnamed disciple and exclaims that someone has taken Jesus. The three go back to the tomb to investigate what has happened and to try and find Jesus's body. The unnamed disciple arrives first, looks into the tomb but does not enter. He sees Jesus's linen wrappings lying on the floor. Then Peter arrives and enters the tomb. He finds the cloth that had been on Jesus's head neatly rolled up and set in a place of its own. Not understanding what has occurred, the two disciples then returned to their homes, leaving Mary Magdalene alone at the tomb. Weeping, she looks into the tomb to find two angels in white sitting where Jesus's body had been lying. The angels ask her why she is weeping. Mary Magdalene responds, "They have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid him." Upon saying this, Jesus appears and asks, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you looking for?" Mistaking him to be the gardener, Mary Magdalene asks him if he knows where he is, to please let her know so she may retrieve him. Jesus calls her by name in which she exclaims, "Rabbouni!" - the Hebrew word for teacher. Jesus tells her that he has not yet ascended to God but to return to everyone and tell them that he will be ascending to God. Mary Magdalene returns and does as Jesus has asked. She rejoices in sharing his message and proclaims, "I have seen the Lord!"

John's Gospel is a story that takes us through many human emotions beginning with searching for the unknown. The story begins in the darkness before dawn. Mary Magdalene only sees the stone removed from the tomb, she does not actually look into the tomb. She only assumes Jesus's body has been removed. Upon further inspection with the two disciples, the three verify his body is gone, but are still under the impression it has been taken by someone unknown. The two disciples then leave and the story then turns to grief as Mary Magdalene is left at the tomb weeping over what she believes has occurred. This is when light comes in as the two angels dressed in white appear. Sadness immediately transforms to surprise as Mary Magdalene realizes the man she has mistaken for the gardener is actually Jesus. Jesus gives her a call to action to spread the word of his ascension. This final emotion in the story, which is to rejoice, is the basis of the Easter celebration. We rejoice that Jesus has risen, a new beginning, a new story. Let us all rejoice in knowing Jesus has risen.
