From the Pews, Brock Koonce

I have had the extraordinary privilege to work with some incredible community organizations. In fact, each day for the past year, I've been blessed to call one of them my job. In my 20+ year career as a working adult, I've seen many vocations. Advertising, higher education, marketing consulting, acting, non-profit, and others. I don't want to make it sound like I've jumped from job to job, but within 20 years, I've been lucky enough to experience a lot of areas of professional life.

Through all of these experiences, I've taken more away than I've given. I've learned more from the people I've worked with than I could ever have imagined. But, it's the work I've done with community organizations or non-profits that has made the biggest impact. For 8 years, I relished my role as Program Director for a brand new, community building non-profit. Through this role I saw the beautiful sides of our incredible County. I also saw many challenges our communities faced on a daily basis. Poverty. Crime. Racism. Sexism. Gentrification. These were the challenges we wanted to face head-on and work to find a solution or a path forward.

It was this work that I thought of when I reflected about this Harbinger cover. It's wonderful to see the beauty and the majesty around us, but we cannot ignore the blight and challenges we face. There are challenges all around us. I wonder if this is what John the Baptist felt as he preached and baptized sinners in the name of God? He let everyone know that forgiveness is given to those who repent and serve the Lord.

I have been reminded about this recently as the organization I work for has started 3 new programs that work to help currently incarcerated individuals transition back to civilian life and find employment. Are these individuals excluded from living a meaningful life because they sinned and payed for their crimes? Don't they deserve an opportunity to repent and be forgiven by God? In talking with many of the participants, we've seen the desire to be forgiven is paramount in their lives. They've acknowledged their sins and only want to live a right and just life. It's amazing to see the transformation that happens when they turn to God and repent. I think it would bring joy to John the Baptist's soul to see the impact it has.
