Westminster Scholarship Award

I. Purpose – To provide financial aid among college and graduate student membership within our church. This year, as of 2022, Westminster is also partnering with local agency, Fostering Great Ideas, so that a portion of funds will support college-bound students in the foster care system. Any Westminster member who will be furthering their education in the fall is eligible to apply.

II. Obligation – Recipient must take advantage of future opportunities to help other students.

IV. Procedure for application

Complete and return the application by **June 24, 2022** (In certain circumstances, if funds are available, renewal and out of cycle requests will be considered). Applications received after this date will not be considered.

VI. Other Information

Each year the Presbyterian Women of Westminster Church offers a scholarship to enable a qualified student to pursue higher education.

This award is intended to encourage the recipient to take every future opportunity to assist other students in need.

Highest consideration will be given to students that would be unable to pursue education without financial aid and to those who intend to pursue a full-time Christian vocation. Other critical factors in choosing scholarship recipients include the student's perceived ability to successfully complete degree requirements in a timely manner and their morality and citizenship (demonstrated by past actions and accomplishments).

In addition to the application form and transcripts, each applicant must write a letter citing the need for the scholarship, stating why the applicant feels they should be considered for this scholarship and the applicant's plan for continuing education. Parents must sign the application. The aid request must be postmarked (or stamped received) at the Westminster administrative office no later than **June 24, 2022**. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. Address all application materials to Westminster Presbyterian Church, 2310 Augusta Street, Greenville, SC 29605.

This scholarship may be renewed, although students are encouraged to provide for themselves as opportunities arise.

Only members of Westminster Presbyterian Church, missionary families of Westminster Presbyterian Church may apply for this aid or Students through Fostering Great Ideas Organization. All information submitted and the scholarship recipient(s) awarded are kept confidential.
